There are never enough hands. Using Audioconferencing saves you money and reduces stress. Less travelling and everyone on time for the meeting: that is what makes audioconferencing an ideal medium for today.

More frequent, but shorter meetings

Audioconferencing is often used supplementary to regular meetings. This speeds up project progress and ensures that co-workers can do their job without information lags. Audioconferencing can be a commitment booster when colleagues are spread across the country, as is often the case for tele-workers.

Single or recurring consultation

KPN's Reserved Audioconferencing is a traditional, operator-supported conference call service. With this service you choose to book your conferences in advance. Although last minute bookings are possible, this service is intended for planned consultation. To make things easier, you can ask for a recurring booking, so that it only takes one call to book, for example, a weekly teleconference.

Easy access

The Reserved Audioconferencing is very easy to access. A simple phone call is all it takes to set up your conference facility. There is no start-up or subscription fee. The service offers ample operator assistance, on working days from 07:00-23:00 (CET).

Dial-in or be called

At the start of the conference an operator may dial your participants or you can let your participants dial-in

them-selves. When KPN dials, it is harder for participants to be 'late' for the conference or even forget all about it. Dialling-in has the advantage that participants do not have to specify in advance from which location they will join the call.

How does it work

At the arranged time, all participants are called, or they dial-in, using a dial-in number and a conference entry code. The participants can be placed directly in conference mode or you can have them listen to music until the chairperson enters the conference. During the conference call everyone can have the floor and hear all other participants. Once the conference is over, all participants can disconnect or some can remain in the conference for an evaluation. The chairperson has the option to disconnect all participants, either via the operator or pressing a touch-tone combination on their phone.

Operator assistance

During your conference, an operator is standby for operator assistance. The operator can divide the meeting into subgroups, put participants in listen only mode or connect extra participants. Some facilities can be used without operator assistance. You can, for instance, 'lock your conference', to be sure no one else can enter. The operator can also give you conferencing tips.
